Over the years he has developed intensive skills in implementation research designs, ethnography, qualitative methodologies, qualitative data generating techniques and analysis/coding, community engagement and mobilization, research findings dissemination, program coordination, facilitation/teaching skills, and media skills for scientists. Before joining NIMR he worked as Social Welfare Officer at Moshi Municipal Council for two and half years, he has also worked as a contractual research assistant for four years at NIMR Amani Centre (TRAction project), a volunteered program coordinator at Kigoma and Ujiji NGO's network in Kigoma Region as well as Secondary school Arts subjects teacher at An Noor Islamic Seminary School, in Tanga and Misalai Secondary School at Amani Muheza, in Tanga region.
